No CDs will be accepted or reviewed. Also, do not send catalogues, slides or color print-outs as they will not be reviewed.

4. Proof of payment of the application fee must be submitted with your application or it will not be reviewed. Checks can be made payable to the Friends of T.C. Steele State Historic Site. Credit card information can be sent in along with application.

**Rules and Regulations:**

The T.C. Steele Great Outdoor Art Contest features fine arts and fine crafts. Work can be in any medium but must be original. It is open to all artists to exhibit and sell work of traditional or contemporary design.

Unacceptable artwork includes:

- Work assembled from kits or molds
- Work constructed from manufactured parts
- Work not made by hand
- Work not made by applicant artist

The committee reserves the right to question any applicant about his or her manufacturing or assembly process.

- ❖ All booths are 10 x 10 feet
- ❖ You are required to provide your own set-up and tear-down
- ❖ Tents and tables are **NOT** provided
- ❖ There is no electrical hook-up
- ❖ Placement will be determined **BEFORE** the event according to our layout
- ❖ **Fee is \$50, a reduced fee is available for non-profit groups**
